PhD supervisions: Two concluded concerning "Otitis media in Greenland". Five other projects concluded within otitis media, sialolithiasis, salivary gland tumors, electrochemotherapy and angioedema and four on-going as head supervisor concerning Obstructive sleep apnea in overweight children, Ventilation tube treatment in Greenlandic children "The Siutit Trial", Tubadysfunction in patients irradiated for head and neck cancer "Dr Tuba", Quality of life in laryngectomised patients and Sleep apnea diabetes and atrial fibrillation".

Scientific focus areas: I have for more than 25 years intensively studied otitis media in especially Greenland. I have a long record of research in medicine in Greenland. Present research activities in Greenland is "The Siutit Trial – a randomized controlled trial of the effect of ventilation tubes in children in Greenland", "Head and neck cancer in Greenland", "Salivary gland tumors in Greenland". At present I perform studies in collaboration with Scandinavian colleagues concerning the microbiome in the middle ear and acute mastoiditis, I have started up a project concerning short term efficacy of ventilation tubes in children which also includes study of the microbiome in middle ear fluid. Throughout 15 years performed research in head and neck surgical oncology and for the last 10 years also salivary gland benign and malignant diseases. I have a profound knowledge in epidemiology and quality assessment studies in various otorhinolaryngological aspects and Head and Neck cancer studies. I am developing a new research area concerning sleep apnea. At present, I am head supervisor for five ph.d.-students and three scholars.
