

# Social Summit II: A Call for Abstracts

- 15th-16th November 2023

**Theme and Overview:** The forthcoming Isumaginninnikkut Ataatsimeersuarnerit II / Social Summit II is centred around "Strong Communities." It serves as a platform for an essential academic and professional forum dedicated to enhancing the synergy between applied social practice and scholarly social research. The Summit aims to provide a continuous space for the robust exchange of insights and expertise between professional practitioners and researchers in social work.

**Abstract Submission Deadline:** The deadline for the submission of abstracts for presentation at the Summit is 1st September 2023.

**Abstract Requirements:** Abstracts submitted should be pertinent to social work or social problems and must include the following elements:

- Title of the presentation
- Name(s) of the presenter(s)
- Job title(s) of the presenter(s)
- Contact email for the primary presenter
- An abstract describing the presentation content, not exceeding 250 words

**Thematic Sessions:** The Summit will feature thematic sessions on:

- Children and Youth
- Homelessness
- Elderly Care
- Pedagogy
- Social Vulnerability in Denmark
- Implementation & Evaluation
- Volunteering
- Disability

Additional themes or sessions may be proposed, and such suggestions are welcomed.
